LOAN REPAYMENT - In 2005, many HVL supporters made loans for the purpose of building the HVL gymnasium. Recently we were notified by one of our generous member-loan lenders that a loan of \$30,000 be returned. We are grateful for the use of these funds over the past few years and wish to honor the request as quickly as possible. The loaner has requested that \$15,000 be paid by the end of September and the remainder by January 15, 2016. At this time HVL is seeking loans or gifts to cover this amount. Over the past five years, we have received similar requests for repayment of loans. In fact, HVL has repaid over \$90,000 in loans to date. Each time we have communicated our need to repay a loan, Association churches and individual supporters of HVL have responded generously and the gifts and loans that were given covered the requested repayment.
